Compulsory Purchase Order 2026

COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER UNDER SECTION 76 OF AND THE THIRD SCHEDULE TO THE HOUSING ACT, 1966, (AS AMENDED), AS EXTENDED BY SECTION 10 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (NO. 2) ACT, 1960, SUBSTITUTED BY SECTION 86 OF THE HOUSING ACT, 1966 (AS AMENDED) AND AS AMENDED AND EXTENDED BY THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2000 (AS AMENDED), THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1925 (AS AMENDED), THE ROADS ACTS 1993 (AS AMENDED) AND ALL OTHER ACTS THEREBY ENABLING THE COMPULSORY ACQUISITION OF LANDS.

WHEREAS in pursuance of the above named Acts the Louth County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the local authority") has decided to effect the acquisition of the land to which this order relates under the Housing Act, 1966 (as amended):

NOW THEREFORE it is hereby ordered that—

1. Subject to the provisions of this order, the Local Authority is hereby authorised:
 - (a) to acquire compulsorily for the purposes of construction of the **Carlingford Public Realm Scheme, Carlingford, Co. Louth**, the lands described in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto and shown on **Deposited Map**, sealed with the seal of the Local

Authority and deposited at the offices of the Local Authority (hereinafter referred to in conjunction with the Drawings specified in sub clauses (b), (c) and (d) hereof as The Deposited Maps)

2. The land described in the Schedule hereto and coloured grey on of The Deposited Map are lands other than land consisting of a house or houses unfit for human habitation and not capable of being rendered fit for human habitation at reasonable expense.

3. Subject to any necessary adaptations, the provisions of:

(a) the Lands Clauses Acts (except sections 127 to 132 of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, and article 20 of the Second Schedule to the Housing of the Working Classes Act, 1890), and

(b) the Acquisition of Land (Assessment of Compensation) Act, 1919, as amended by the Acquisition of Land (Reference Committee) Act, 1925, the Property Values (Arbitrations and Appeals) Act, 1960, and the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963 (as applied by section 265(3) of the Planning and Development Acts, 2000), and the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.


