Screening Assessment Determination

Louth County Council, in accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended, has undertaken Appropriate Assessment Screening on the proposed development of Termonfeckin Playground, in view of best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of the site, if the works, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, are likely to have a significant effect on a European Site(s).

In accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011, as amended, Louth County Council has made a determination that Appropriate Assessment is not required, as it can be concluded on the basis of information provided by Mulroy Environmental Ltd in their report titled Appropriate Assessment Screening Report for Proposed playground, Baltray Road, Termonfeckin, Co. Louth, September 2023, that the works, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, are not likely to have a significant effect on any European Sites.
