# **Streetscape Enhancement Measure 2022 - Omeath**



#### PART A - GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SCHEME

## **Scheme Overview**

Our Rural Future is the Government's five year strategy to revitalise rural Ireland and includes a commitment to upgrade and enhance shopfronts and street facades in our rural towns and villages.

This activity will be funded by the Department of Rural and Community Development (DRCD) through the 2022 Streetscape Enhancement Measure.

The Streetscape Enhancement Measure for **Omeath** will be administered through Louth County Council who has the right to use discretion with regard to the process and the development of terms and conditions that are appropriate. All applicants are required to comply with statutory planning codes or other relevant legislative provisions.

The focus of this Scheme is to support the upgrade and enhancement of shopfronts and street facades within the village of Omeath, with a focus on the village centre as identified on the map. (See page 4).

## What works are Eligible?

Eligible works include painting of buildings/shopfronts, signage replacement, shopfront improvement including replacement shop fronts, green enhancement of entrances/terraces, appropriate illumination and lighting of architectural features of buildings, provision of canopies/awnings.

In the event of the scheme being oversubscribed, priority will be accorded to premises located centrally in Omeath.\*(See map on page 4)

Applications may not be considered where there are commercial rates or charges due to Louth County Council. However, consideration will be given if an agreed payment plan is in place.

Depending on the type of works you wish to carry out you may need planning permission. Applicants are advised to consult Louth County Council Shop Front Design Guidelines. Shop Front Design Guidelines

If your property is listed as a Protected Structure, you must contact the Planning Department for advice and guidance before carrying out any works. Phone 042 9335457.

Applicants are responsible for ensuring that relevant planning permissions are in place before undertaking any works. Where planning permission is required, the time period for the making and processing of an application must be factored into the timescale of the Streetscape Enhancement Scheme. It takes eight weeks for the planning authority to process an application once it is lodged and longer if further information is required. Applicants are responsible for all costs associated with planning applications where they are required.

#### **Grant Rates**

| Category of Works  | Max grant available |
|--|---------------------|
| Green enhancement of entrances/ terraces with planting   | €500                |
| Painting of building/shop front in carefully selected colours which will complement the host building and streetscape.             | €3,500              |
| Mural (must be agreed in advance with Louth County Council).   |                     |
| Decluttering and repair of shopfronts. (Decluttering can include such works as removing unnecessary signs, flagpoles, wiring etc). |                     |
| Appropriate illumination and lighting of architectural features of buildings.  | €4,000              |
| Replacement of signage with traditional wooden fascia with wooden/hand painted lettering OR contemporary design.                   |                     |
| Canopies/Awnings complementary to the materials of the shopfront and building (including street furniture).                        |                     |

Note: Maximum grant available per building (across all category of works) is €8,000.

Under the scheme 80% of the total eligible costs will be granted, up to the max of relevant category and the remaining 20% of the costs are to be met by the applicant. In the case of painting undertaken by direct labour by the applicant, 90% of the eligible materials cost up to the max of the relevant category will be granted and the remaining 10% of costs are to be met by the applicant.

# Criteria for painting buildings


Where the application is for painting, please note the following:

- The preference is for bright colours that come from a similar palette that will help to strengthen the village identity.
- No creams, magnolias, blacks or very dark greys will be accepted.
- The proposed colour and shade is to be agreed with Louth County Council and details must be submitted with the application.
- A dark grey has been included in the suggested colour scheme (see below), however, this should be used as an accent colour rather than for a full elevation.
- Two adjacent properties should not share the same colour, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Louth County Council
- The colours are being suggested in response to the Public Realm upgrade of Omeath.

## **Documentation required to apply**

The scheme will be open from Tuesday the 6<sup>th</sup> September 2022 for applications. **The scheme will close at 12 noon on Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022**.

- Completed application form
- 2 x contractor quotes
- 1 x materials quote
- Photograph of the property before works are undertaken
- Completed payment details form
- Note: 3 written quotes required for contracts above €5,000 as per National Procurement Guidelines.
- Failure to submit all information required will deem an application invalid.

# **Timeline for Funding Applications**

All approved works must be completed and all final claims for payment must be submitted by the 30<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Payment of the grant will be made on receipt of:

- A photograph of the works completed
- Invoices and receipts/evidence of payment for works completed; and
- Evidence, where planning permission is required, that the relevant consents were in place at the time of undertaking the works.
