

Review of Protected Structures

Louth County Council are undertaking a review of the Record of Protected Structures in the County. This review will consider additions, deletions, or amendments to the Record of Protected Structures.

Have Your Say!!

As part of this review process the Council would welcome input from across the entire community. This includes, but is not restricted to, property owners whose property is currently included in the Record of Protected Structures or property owners who would like their property to be added to the Record of Protected Structures.

Content of submissions

To assist in the review process it would be beneficial if submissions included supporting documentation such as photographs and a rationale (preferably by a suitably qualified professional with experience in the management and/or conservation of historic buildings) as to why the building/structure should be added or deleted to the Record of Protected Structures or if an amendment to the description of the building/structure in the Record of Protected Structures is required.

A map indicating the location of the property should also be included with any submission.

Closing date of consultation

Submissions should be made on or before 4.30pm on Wednesday 30th April 2025.
